

Child Find

The Beresford School District is required by law and conscience to provide appropriate educational opportunities for all children, regardless of their special education needs. In light of this, Superintendent Brian Field of the Beresford School District announces that the district is conducting an annual “Child Find” search to identify and evaluate all district children, under age 21, who may not be receiving appropriate educational opportunities.

Krislyn Carlson of the Beresford School District has been named Child Find Coordinator.

Persons who know of a child in this school district with inappropriate or un-served educational needs may give the child’s name to Krislyn Carlson at 763-5012. After obtaining parental consent, the district will conduct an evaluation of the child’s needs, and determine educational needs.

Superintendent Field stresses that parents are not expected to be able to diagnose a child’s difficulty before they ask for help. He also said, “It is the philosophy of the Beresford School District to see that every child, regardless of their special needs, may develop to their fullest potential.”
