Shanna Rae Christensen Memorial Scholarship

A special scholarship fund was set up by the David and Susan Christensen family in memory of their daughter Shanna Rae. The scholarship fund agreement was set up with the South Dakota Community Foundation as a sub-fund of the Watchdog Education Foundation and affiliated fund of the Beresford Area Foundation.

A scholarship will be awarded annually to a Beresford High School senior whose intended plan of post-high study will be in the area of special education, rehabilitation, or nursing. The senior must have two letters of recommendation from individuals who can speak to character and activity involvement. The senior must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher, demonstrate good moral character, and be involved in community, church and/or school activities. Work and/or volunteer experience with special needs children is preferred but not required.

Interested and qualifying members of the graduating senior class should return their typed or computer generated application into the guidance counselor by the *first Friday in March*.

The Watchdog Education Foundation Board of Directors will select the Shanna Rae Christensen Scholarship recipient at their quarterly board meeting on the second Wednesday in March. The scholarship will be awarded at the Senior Academic Recognition Ceremony in May.

Criteria for the scholarship are as follows:

- -Graduating senior student from Beresford High School.
- -Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- -Demonstrate good moral character.
- -Be involved in community, church and/or school activities.
- -Work and/or volunteer experience with special needs children is preferred but not required.
- -Intended plan of post-high study in the area of special education, rehabilitation, or nursing.
- -Must have two letters of recommendation from individuals who can speak to senior's character and activity involvement.
